The kitchen will be serving a celebration meal on 18th May. Please pay for the meal in the usual way on parentpay.

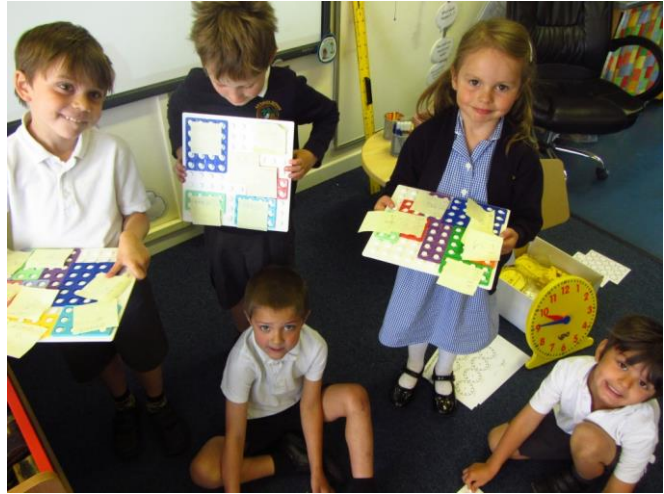

Founded in 1879, we have a long history of delivering cricket coaching for children of primary school age and have developed a structured cricket programme for boys and girls of all ages and abilities.

- Under 11 Hardball

Aimed at School Years 5-6 this is competitive cricket played with a proper cricket ball. Players will wear whites and protective equipment. There is a full schedule of league and cup matches played on Monday evenings in the Burton & District Youth League. Training is on Thursdays from 6.30 to 7.30pm.

- Under 10 Incrediball

Aimed at School Years 4-5 this is semi-competitive cricket played with a heavy plastic cricket ball. Players will wear whites and protective equipment. There is a full schedule of matches played on Tuesday evenings. Training is also on Thursdays from 6.30 to 7.30pm.

- **Kwik Cricket**

Aimed at School Years 1-4 this is a fun introduction to cricket played with light plastic bats and balls. There is no need to wear whites or any protective equipment. Training is on Mondays from 6.00 to 7.00pm and there is a full schedule of matches played on Friday evenings.

- Girls only

Although girls are just as welcome as boys throughout the programme, to encourage and promote the participation of girls there are girls only training sessions on Tuesdays from 6.00 to 7.00pm with girls only tournaments on Sunday afternoons. Girls in School Years 2-6 are welcome.

- All Stars

Aimed at School Years 1-3 this is an 8 week introductory cricket programme introduced this year by the England & Wales Cricket Board (ECB). Alrewas Cricket Club is a registered All Stars Cricket Centre and will be delivering the programme on behalf of the ECB on Monday evenings from 6.00 to 7.00pm starting on 14th May. All details, including registration and payment are online at the ECB's dedicated All Stars Cricket portal.
